

Urea solution UFF® – Opti N15

Nutrient:

Total nitrogen (N) content in the amide form 14.5% (m/m)

Instructions for use

Urea Solution UFF® – Opti N15 - During spring sowing, the entire amount of N can be applied straight away by placing/deflecting the fertiliser. In established crops, we recommend applying up to 80 kg N/ha. The high amide-N content of Opti-N 15 provides plants with an even amount of nitrogen over several weeks. It ensures even and adequate formation of side shoots and masses.

Dose, manner and timing of application:

- application is by means of fertiliser nozzles, which deliver heavy drops falling vertically through the crop
 - on the ground,
 - fertiliser does not need to be diluted with water before use,
- Application should be avoided during periods of frost and strong sunlight. Freezing temperature -5 °C
